



2022 Foster Grandparent and Senior Companion Volunteer Guidelines and Benefits:

Guidelines:

- Must be 55 year or older and a Blair County Resident.
- Income Single \$27,180 per year (\$2,265 per month)
 Married \$36,620 per year (\$3,051.67 per month)
- Pass Criminal Background Checks and Child Abuse History Clearance
- Must volunteer a <u>minimum of 5 hours per week</u>, and may choose to volunteer up to 40 hours per week.
- Senior Companions help seniors in their homes and throughout the community maintain their independence. Senior Companions must be flexible and have a willingness to help others.
- Foster Grandparents assist teachers in elementary schools and Head Start programs by providing learning support to students who would benefit from extra help with daily tasks, reading and math.

Benefits:

- \$3 per hour tax free stipend doesn't affect any other assistance. The program is grant funded by AmeriCorps Seniors.
- Bus Pass or Mileage Reimbursement
- Free Transportation on the Blair Senior Services, Inc. van for individuals 65+
- Annual Volunteer Recognition
- AmeriCorps Seniors Apparel
- Yearly lab work and physical
- Monthly In-service paid day and free lunch
- Annual PTO (paid time off)
- 11 Paid Holidays
- 40 hours Orientation & Training paid plus lunch is provided
- Awareness of programs offered through Blair Senior Services, Inc.
- Opportunity to help students and older adults.
