GENERAL INFORMATION

All team members/partners must register individually. Teams will be matched by team/partner name listed. The age group for doubles and team events will be determined by the age of the youngest participant. If an athlete does not have a specific partner or team to participate with, they may still sign up for the event and will be paired with teammates based on athlete availability. Pairings will be made on a first-come, first-served basis.

A medal will be awarded to first, second and third place for each event.

The schedule of events is subject to change. Rain dates will be announced as needed.

Warm-up and practice time will be provided prior to the start of an event.

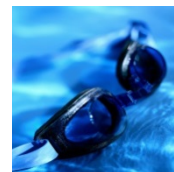

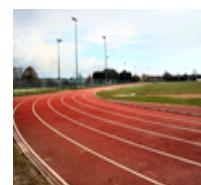

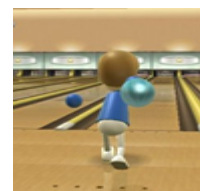
